- Selbstbildnis Painted in the summer of 1933, this
self-portrait belongs to the figurative culture of
southern Germany between the two World Wars,
where the legacy of Expressionism remains
visible even within more traditional approaches to
representation. The painting is built on clear
chromatic tensions and a solid, plastic
construction of form, characteristic of German
portraiture of the period, balancing expressive
intensity with formal discipline. August Hirsching
was active in Stuttgart, where he studied at the
Technische Hochschule, within the artistic milieu
of Württemberg, a region in which many painters

of his generation maintained a compact and severe figurative language, shaped by the experience of Expressionism but oriented, during the 1930s, toward a more stable form in relation to the climate of the Neue Sachlichkeit and regional German realism. Good overall condition. Fine patina.
