The tabletop boasts spectacular natural veining where shades of deep black, anthracite, mineral gray, and white swirls intertwine. Its lines are remarkably pure: a large rectangular tabletop resting on a solid central block base. This "totem-like" design visually lightens the table while giving it a presence worthy of an art gallery. It integrates perfectly into a sophisticated decor, whether ultra-contemporary to add character, or in a "Mix & Match" interior with tubular furniture or classic wood. stone has been carefully cleaned and retains a beautiful shine. Please note: An old transverse crack on the tabletop has been professionally restored. It is very neatly filled, smooth to the touch, and solid (see close-up detail photos), but remains visible depending on the angle of the light.
