### Description

The dense and colorful composition brings together various floral varieties--peonies, tulips, daisies, and small garden flowers--rendered with particular care in the detail of the petals and nuances. The whole stands out against a deep, dark background, a technique typical of 17th-century Flemish still lifes, which highlights the brilliance of the colors and the delicacy of the forms. The soft, directed light reveals the volumes and lends the scene an intimate and elegant atmosphere. The work is probably French, from the 19th century, inspired by the great tradition of Flemish and Dutch

painters of the Baroque era. This type of painting was then highly valued for interior decoration, employing the classical conventions of symbolic and decorative bouquets.
