Description

Glazed stoneware vase with a central motif of stylized leaves framed at the neck and base by friezes of geometric patterns. In the 1930s, the François du Sablon pottery in Malicorne produced stoneware with a modern aesthetic, in keeping with the Art Deco movement. It ceased operations in 1939. The treatment of the decoration, geometric yet also fluid and organic, and the colors--the blue outline of the leaves against a gray background, here enriched with brushed shades of mauve and lime green--create a piece that is both characteristic and unique. A circular stamp, "RF ses grès son art Malicorne," is impressed above the motto "Le feu est notre maître" (Fire is our master); a monogram is on the body of the vase. 1930s Very good condition - a very small chip on the rim of the base.
