Bowl from the factory of Mrs. Franziska Hirsch, founded in 1894. The signature was used from 1894 to 1896 in Dresden (Germany - Saxony). The imitators of the Meissen blue crossed sword mark. In 1894, Franziska Hirsch founded a painting workshop located at Struwestrasse 19 where porcelain was decorated in the Meissen style. In 1896, the KPM factory in Meissen filed a formal complaint against Hirsch for imitating its patented factory mark. The complaint was upheld, and Hirsch was prohibited from using the mark.
