An 18-karat gold ring with Egyptian-inspired decoration, set with a square lapis lazuli centered with an old-cut diamond, mounted on silver. The sides of the ring are carved with pharaoh heads in a relief style characteristic of the taste for ancient Egypt. Egyptomania experienced a surge in popularity during the 19th century, following the Egyptian campaigns and archaeological discoveries, inspiring numerous pieces of jewelry featuring pharaoh motifs and ancient symbols. Circa 1880. Very good overall condition, with a minor chip to the lapis lazuli. Gross weight: 12.4 g.
