A charming Aubusson tapestry, dating from the 17th or 18th century, depicting a mythological or allegorical scene. The mythologically inspired decoration is treated allegorically, reflecting the taste for verdant historiated tapestries of the 17th and 18th centuries, without the precise identification of an ancient episode. In the center, an elegantly draped female figure is depicted in a lush garden, surrounded by stylized figures arranged on either side, evoking decorative motifs. The composition is organized around a dense vegetal background, enlivened by a small dog in the foreground, bringing life and a touch of whimsy to the whole. The design, both naive and expressive, reflects the style of antique furnishing tapestries, where mythological inspiration blends with ornamental fantasy. A
