This vibrant work, a brilliant creation by an unknown artist named Cots, visually transposes the second song from Mahler's *Lieder eines fahrenden Gesellen*, capturing the morning euphoria of a world awakening with freshness and optimism. Through a post-impressionist palette of fiery yellows and oranges, the painter manages to materialize the brilliance of the dew and the vivacity of the sun, while the greens and purples of the mountains evoke the purity of the air. The energetic brushstrokes and the rhythm of the foliage mimic the pace of a brisk walk, inviting the viewer to traverse this winding path as a true walking companion in communion with nature. Cots's elegance lies in his ability to transform an ordinary rural scene into a sublime experience
