It is lined with bright red silk and weighted with cotton at the bottom to ensure a perfect drape. It bears a signature on the reverse (its provenance is the Hayashi kimono house, a historic firm founded in Tokyo in 1913). In Japan, wearing a wedding kimono with embroidered colorful fans is highly symbolic. These motifs promise the couple a happy, prosperous, and lucky future. This kimono is in excellent condition and, with the addition of a simple bamboo pole, can be transformed into a potential decorative centerpiece.
