The front features two drawers in the frieze, each adorned with a delicately chased, gilt-bronze leaf motif and fitted with a functional lock and key. The lower rail, with its sculpted and undulating shape, gracefully initiates the curved line of the legs, whose gentle curve lends the piece a lively and refined appearance. The top is covered in black leather, framed by a gilt vignette and accompanied by a blind-tooled vignette, offering a sophisticated contrast to the wood's color. The molded rim, crafted in an inverted quarter-round, completes this charming piece of furniture, a testament to the 18th century, where refined proportions and gentle forms combined to
