This refined set of six beech armchairs, finished in their original pale green lacquer, embodies the exquisite craftsmanship of the late 18th century. Their design harmoniously blends strength and elegance: the rear sabre legs, characteristic of the era, contrast with the front "Jacob" legs, while the finely carved connecting blocks--each fitted with scrapers--support baluster-shaped uprights. The generous seats and reclined backrests provide remarkable comfort, enhancing both their practicality and aesthetic appeal.
