Of circular form, the dish features an elegant rim adorned with fine concentric mouldings, whose restrained design highlights the exceptional quality of both the silver and the craftsmanship. The overall composition reflects a perfect balance between refinement and sobriety, characteristic of early 19th-century French silverware. The hallmarks are clearly visible: French coq 1 hallmark (950 silver standard) Odiot workshop mark Lozenge-shaped
