Description

Louis Dage (1935-1957) Art Deco glazed ceramic from the Antony workshop (1921-1934). Height: 35 cm, diameter: 20 cm. Louis Dage (1885-1961) was a French ceramicist whose career spanned the Paris region and the Landes, where he settled in 1935. He worked notably at the Faïencerie de l'Adour in Saint-Sever and developed a rich and experimental body of work, blending Art Nouveau and Art Deco influences with reinterpretations of Samadet designs. His work is distinguished by the diversity of techniques used--glazes, drips, crackle glazes, and inlays--and by great creative freedom. Long overlooked, he is now being rediscovered as an original figure in 20th-century French ceramics.
