A charming tall Swedish sideboard in softwood, opening at the front with two framed panel doors surmounted by two drawers in the frieze.

Balanced in proportion and shallow, this piece displays a clean and functional design characteristic of late 19th-century Scandinavian furniture, in the late Gustavian style. The top features a small stepped shelf with side panels, a typical element of Swedish domestic sideboards, originally used to display dishes or everyday objects. The interior, left in its natural wood finish, offers ample storage space with shelves, attesting to its utilitarian purpose. The doors lock (key included), and the drawers are fitted with simple turned knobs. The entire piece is finished with a soft and luminous light gray patina that highlights the simplicity of the lines and
