Description

Still Life with Ladybug - oil on panel, 19th century (in the Old Master style) BEARS AN ILLEGIBLE SIGNATURE (see photo) Charming oil on panel depicting a refined still life, composed of an elegant bouquet of flowers delicately arranged in a bowl, accompanied by bunches of grapes, half-eaten citrus fruits, and a bottle of wine. The scene is subtly enlivened by the presence of a ladybug, a discreet and poetic detail that brings life and symbolism to the composition. The whole is rendered in a warm and deep palette, with beautiful chiaroscuro work reminiscent of the tradition of European still lifes, in the spirit of intimate compositions in the manner of Jean-Baptiste-Siméon Chardin. The materials are rendered with care: the transparency of the glass, the freshness of the fruit, the delicacy
