Model held in the collections of the Musée des Arts Décoratifs, Paris, France, Inv.: 54040 Sabine Charoy was born in France and studied at the École Camondo for architecture and design. She initially worked as an interior designer before turning to product design. Charoy worked with Janette Laverrière and Gio Ponti before meeting Max Ingrand and joining the French company Verre Lumière. This lamp is composed of white lacquered and chromed enameled metal, plexiglass, and a compact fluorescent lamp (CFL).
