A finely sculpted marble head of a bearded male figure, his face turned heavenward in a pose charged with spirituality and intensity. From the circle of Girolamo Ticciati (1679-1745), this work is part of the tradition of 18th-century Italian Baroque sculpture. It stands out for the quality of the workmanship, the style of the models, and the refinement of the details, particularly the delicately chiseled hair and beard.
