Description

This Belgian Art Deco giltwood mirror, dating from around 1920, is a remarkable example of early 20th-century decorative design, where geometric modernism met the enduring elegance of classical ornamentation. Its distinctive, angular, architectural silhouette, topped with a pointed crest, exemplifies the experimental boldness that defined Belgian Art Deco, a movement renowned for its marriage of sculptural forms and luxurious materials. The frame is crafted from giltwood, its surface enhanced with warm golden tones that accentuate the interplay of carved details and precise geometry. Vertical fluted columns anchor each side, lending the mirror a sense of structure and symmetry, while the lower edge features a flowing, wave-like motif that softens the

composition with a touch of drama. Decorative tassels, suspended from the upper corners, introduce a playful yet refined touch, echoing the opulent interiors of the 1920s. The mirror hangs from a twisted gold cord, a period detail that enhances its authenticity and charm. Belgium in the 1920s was a fertile ground for Art Deco innovation, drawing inspiration from French influences while developing its own expressive language. This mirror reflects that era: modern in its lines, ornamental in its spirit, and crafted with the meticulous attention to detail characteristic of Belgian workshops. The combination of rigorous geometry and decorative richness makes it a prized piece for collectors of early Art Deco design.
