Description

Drypoint etching dating from 1939, listed in Alain Viray's catalogue raisonné of engraved works, "Paul-Auguste Masui, Engravings, Pastels," as "Breton Scenes: The Cider Tent," G365, page 177. Limited edition of only 50 prints. A scene that took place during a pardon (pilgrimage) near Notre-Dame de la Joie in Penmarc'h, which can be discerned in the background. Signed lower right, unnumbered, and titled "The Cider Tent (Brittany)" lower left. Dimensions: 36cm x 30cm with frame. In very good condition. Paul-Auguste Masui made his first trip to Brittany, to the Crozon peninsula, to Camaret, in 1925 and it was love at first sight; his period of Breton production would extend until the end of the 1930s. Retrospective at the Pont-Aven Museum in 2007.
