Description

Height: 28 cm, Total length with handles: 30 cm, Depth: 22.5 cm. France, late 19th century. An elegant pair of polychrome majolica cachepots, worked in high relief, fully illustrating the abundant naturalistic aesthetic of the late 19th century. Each piece has a generous silhouette, emphasized by a richly modeled ovoid body and enhanced with high-relief decoration combining stylized floral motifs, organic scrolls, and arabesques inspired by the plant vocabulary characteristic of Art Nouveau. The presence of sculptural side handles gives the whole an almost theatrical dimension, typical of the most virtuoso majolica workshops of the period. The rich color palette combines deep turquoise, royal blue, powder pink, brown, and cream, creating a play of subtle and luminous contrasts. The interior of

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the pieces is entirely glazed in a brilliant pink, adding an unexpected and refined touch. The meticulously modeled and perfectly executed decoration testifies to remarkable craftsmanship: crisp reliefs, fluid chromatic transitions, and a harmonious symmetrical composition. Condition: Both pieces are in perfect condition, without any cracks, chips, or visible restoration. The glaze retains all its brilliance, and the reliefs are intact. Note: A rare pair due to its condition, its exquisitely detailed relief decoration, and the quality of its polychromy. A decorative ensemble of remarkable presence.
