An important Louis XIII period wardrobe in solid walnut, of fine craftsmanship, dating from the 17th century, featuring an elegant, richly molded front. It opens with two doors adorned with panels of geometric and scalloped decoration, typical of regional production in eastern France (work similar to Louis XIII/Louis XIV models). The finely molded frames harmoniously structure the front and highlight the beauty of the wood. The lower section comprises two drawers in the frieze, embellished with bronze handles and keyhole escutcheons. The piece rests on short, cabriole legs, ensuring stability and elegance. The interior, made of natural wood, offers ample storage space with shelves, ideal for linens or household items. The wardrobe retains its original hardware, hinges, and lock. The top is crowned
