Lotus dining table attributed to Vivai del Sud This is a vintage dining table crafted from thin reed stalks, bamboo, and rattan in the shape of a flower with large petals, topped by a round, beveled glass tabletop. The glass tabletop offers a clear view of the artistic reed base, creating an airy and open atmosphere. The use of reed stems emphasizes the artisanal quality and craftsmanship. These tables are attributed to Vivai del Sud, a leading Italian manufacturer of luxury furniture and interiors founded in 1950 in Rome by the Di Pierri brothers. The base shows wear at the feet, and there are minor signs of use and patina here and there, consistent with its age and use. The tabletop shows only micro-scratches that are barely noticeable. The base is 105 cm wide and 73 cm high. The tabletop has a diameter of 122 cm.
