A richly carved, solid oak Norman wedding armoire, dating from the Louis XV period/18th century. The high-quality carving features abundant decoration of grape bunches, foliage, flowers, birds, and a central basket, typical of regional French furniture (Normandy). The doors are framed by carved uprights with a decorated central pilaster. The high cornice is finely crafted with a raised floral frieze. The shaped base is also carved. It retains its original long brass handles. The lock is functional with an antique key. The interior includes shelves. The armoire is made of solid oak with a sound and robust structure.
