Provenance: Former charity sale in a deconsecrated convent in Flanders. Support and intervention: Original canvas; cleaning was necessary as the work was illegible. Minor retouching and re-stretching of the canvas were required. Frame: The frame is new, made of gilded wood in a classical Regency style.
