An elegant bust-length portrait of a gentleman, depicted in armor and wearing a dark coat with a lace collar, characteristic of the nobility during the reign of Louis XIV. The face, rendered with finesse, reveals a masterful use of skin tones and a presence imbued with dignity and authority. This work belongs to the tradition of formal portraiture of the late 17th century, in the style of great portrait painters such as Hyacinthe Rigaud and Nicolas de Largillière. It is presented in its remarkable period carved and gilded wooden frame, richly decorated with scrolling foliage and other foliate motifs, perfectly in keeping with the work and contributing fully to its authenticity and prestige.
