Description

A rare and beautiful large porcelain vase with a matte painted decoration of scrolling foliage and flowers, featuring a flared neck with pierced holes and a scalloped edge, this remarkable piece dates from 1890 and is by the artist Pouillat. This elegant and richly decorated piece from the late 19th century has everything to charm with its shape and its meticulous and virtuoso decoration. A unique vase, its entirely matte body lends it originality. Painted on a white base, the rich decoration emphasizes the shape of this unique, high-quality vase. With its rounded shape and corolla-like neck, this piece, with its preserved and unworn decoration, belongs to the pre-Art Nouveau period and foreshadows a liberated graphic style on the theme of plants.
