Louis XV period library in rosewood veneer, within frames of violetwood and rosewood, opening with two glazed doors with shaped uprights over five shelves. Gilded bronze ornaments. Stamped J. SCHMITZ (Joseph SCHMITZ, received master in Paris on June 18, 1761) and Jurande JME mark. Very good original condition, lock and hinges replaced, probably period blown glass.
