The uprights are highlighted with fluted molding, typical of the Louis XVI style, and terminate in tapered feet with rings. The cornice is adorned with a carved frieze decorated with interlaced ribbons, surmounted by small corner cubes, reminiscent of neoclassical decorative motifs.
