### Description

An artist who witnessed his time, Victor Coste often depicts seafarers, fishermen, and sailors at work, but always in a peaceful and poetic atmosphere, using a range of soft colors skillfully applied to a beautiful texture. This work will appeal to those nostalgic for an era when, despite the arduous nature of the work, people did not shy away from the task, and when, like this solitary fisherman mending his nets, work well done was carried out with wisdom and experience. The painting, in very good condition, is an oil on panel and is presented in a lovely Louis XIV-style frame with a gilt patina, measuring 38.5 cm x 49 cm (the panel itself measures 23 cm x 32.5 cm).
