Inscription: Some bear the inventory number (1253), suggesting they originated from a notebook containing a narrative inspired by ancient tales. Condition: Absolutely impeccable, with beautiful freshness of color and no foxing.

Framing: This must have been expensive, as they were framed by the renowned framing firm 'Schleipper'. The frames are made of gilded wood and have anti-reflective glass. *Viewable at 'Sablon Antiques Center', 39 Place du Grand
