In the Middle Ages, this motif was considered a true lucky charm, a symbol of good fortune, prosperity, and abundant food for the coming year. The decoration, in brown slip on a yellow background, is still remarkably legible and testifies to the skill of the workshops of the period. This tile is in exceptional condition considering its age: it retains its entire original glaze and has only one small, discreet chip.
