A charming brooch depicting a stylized spider, crafted in brass or gilt metal, typical of mid-20th-century Czechoslovakian production. The body is adorned with a large, faceted, slightly amethyst-pink rhinestone, adding sparkle and dimension to the design. The head is embellished with two small, colorless rhinestones reminiscent of diamonds. The overall effect is simple yet expressive, characteristic of Central European costume jewelry from the interwar and immediate postwar periods. The clasp is signed "Czechoslovakia," indicating that it was made for export, a common practice for these pieces between the 1930s and 1950s. Characteristics:
