Description

Charles Reussner (20th century) Stylized Doe - Bronze with a medal patina, on a stone base. La Musardièrè presents an elegant animal sculpture by Reussner, representative of the 20th-century revival of decorative sculpture, where the stylization of forms enhances the natural subject. This doe, rendered with great restraint of line, is distinguished by its slender and harmonious silhouette. The deliberately refined modeling accurately conveys the grace and lightness of the animal, in a resolutely modernist spirit, inherited from the Art Deco aesthetic and its extensions. The warm and nuanced medal patina highlights the volumes and subtly captures the light, accentuating the smoothness of the transitions and the finesse of the surface work. The animal rests on an organically shaped natural stone base,

which engages in a dialogue with the sculpture and reinforces its decorative and sculptural character. This type of presentation, typical of high-quality mid-20th-century works, situates the piece within a quest for balance between raw material and stylized form. The Reussner signature, visible on the hind leg, authenticates this piece and places it within the tradition of European animal sculptors of the last century. In very good condition.
