Description

Superb bronze sculpture depicting a man controlling a rearing horse, inspired by Guillaume Coustou's famous Marly Horses (signed on the base). This composition is emblematic of French sculpture and illustrates the strength and movement of the subject: the horse rearing in a powerful impulsion, held by a man in a dynamic and expressive pose. The whole is richly detailed with a beautiful quality of modeling (musculature, mane, drapery). The sculpture rests on a decorative bronze base, itself supported by a wooden plinth. Width of the plinth: 40 cm, Depth: 17 cm.
