A rare pair of early Minton porcelain figural candlesticks representing a young flower seller and her companion, dating to circa 1835-1836 and corresponding to pattern number 192.

The figures are decorated in bright enamels with gilding and stand on rococo bases with applied flowers. Behind the figures rise candlesticks modelled as bundles of reeds and bulrushes. The modelling reflects the refined decorative style of early Minton porcelain.
