Description

Oil on canvas depicting a refined portrait after Perugino, executed in the historicist tradition that characterized much of 18th-century European artistic production. The work closely follows the model of the famous Portrait of Perugino, attributed to Pietro Perugino, housed in the collection of the Collegio del Cambio at the Palazzo dei Priori in Perugia. This composition reflects the renewed interest in the Italian Renaissance that emerged from the 18th century onward, when travelers, collectors, and scholars rediscovered the artistic achievements of the Umbrian school. Perugino, Raphael's teacher and a central figure of Renaissance idealism, became an essential reference for academic training and artistic emulation. The painting adheres to the canonical principles of Renaissance portraiture: a

bust, a neutral background, soft lighting, and a serene, introspective expression that conveys dignity and balance. These qualities made this composition a benchmark in academic circles, where copying such works was an essential part of artistic training.
