Sculptural Set of Three Space Age Nesting Tables Textured Glass by Saint-Gobain France, Circa 1970. An exceptional sculptural set of three nesting side tables executed in France circa 1970, embodying the bold architectural vocabulary of the Space Age period. Each element is conceived as a monolithic inverted U-shaped volume with softly curved inner radii and a textured gilt lacquered finish. The tables are topped with thick moulded and granulated glass panels produced by Saint-Gobain, whose subtle green tint and mineral surface enhance the futuristic and industrial character of the ensemble. The design reflects the experimental spirit of late modernist interiors, where furniture became both functional object and spatial sculpture. When nested, the three tables form a powerful architectural composition;

when separated, they function elegantly as side tables or end tables. Their narrow and elongated proportions make them particularly suitable for refined contemporary interiors, architectural projects, collectible design environments or curated gallery settings. This type of French Space Age production -- often created in small series by decorators or specialised workshops -- is increasingly sought after for its strong presence and decorative versatility. Good vintage condition with age-appropriate wear. Minor losses and wear to the textured lacquered finish. Two localized chips to glass edges. Structurally sound and stable.
