Description

A striking early 20th-century French mirror, dating from around 1905, that combines the expressive curves of Art Nouveau with the handcrafted authenticity of the Arts & Crafts movement. This piece is distinguished by its sculptural metalwork, richly textured surface, and exquisite ornamentation; a striking example of the artistic experimentation that flourished in France at the turn of the century. The frame has a gently arched silhouette, its contours softened by a mottled patina in deep green tones. At the corners and center, finely chased metal leaves unfurl into organic and asymmetrical forms, classic Art Nouveau motifs inspired by the flowing lines of nature. These elements are not merely decorative; they reflect the Arts & Crafts movement's belief in the authenticity of materials

and visible craftsmanship. Small, round cabochon stones in rich shades of blue and multicolored are set within the frame. These accents introduce a subtle impression of luxury and refinement, capturing the light and adding depth to the overall composition of the mirror. Their placement--at the top, bottom, and lower corners--creates a balanced rhythm that guides the eye around the frame.
