### Description

This sculpture depicts a winged cherub, a decorative and artistic element of Italian origin, dating from the late 17th to early 18th century, the Baroque period, and originating from Liguria, Italy. Characteristics of the work  
The object exhibits the typical characteristics of antique statuary: Materials and finish: The sculpture is made of assembled bronze with a golden patina. The gilding is visible over most of the body, while some areas show signs of wear or oxidation that reveal the underlying material. Subject: A cherub (or angel) in a dynamic pose, draped around the hips with outstretched wings. The figure rests on a cloud-shaped base, a detail that emphasizes its celestial nature. The style and pose are reminiscent of the Baroque period, when these figures were used as furniture, candle
