Naar Apol porcelain plaque. Oil on porcelain plaque, "The Cart in the Forest Path," bears the signature L. Apol preceded by the N of Naar (after). 60.5 x 40 cm. Dutch School.

Lodewyk-Franciscus-Hendrik Apol, known as Louis Apol (1850-1936), is one of the best-known representatives of the Hague School. He painted primarily seascapes and winter landscapes. Many national and international museums possess his works. Our painting is a good example of the international popularity of the Hague School towards the end of the 19th century. Indeed, manufacturers like Rozenburg in The Hague, or even Parisian firms, bought the reproduction rights from painters to copy successful motifs. Louis Apol collaborated with major manufacturers to produce decorative art
