Jean-Claude QUILICI, Taos Pueblo in New Mexico, oil on canvas, 46 x 61 cm, signed lower left. Located on the reverse. In the United States, in the valley of a small tributary of the Rio Grande, Taos Pueblo (the place of the red willows) refers to a collection of adobe dwellings and ceremonial centers, remarkably representative of the culture of the Pueblo Indians of Arizona and New Mexico. It is located approximately 110 km north of Santa Fe. The territory surrounding the pueblo is an Indian Reservation.
