### Description

This mahogany and rosewood screen, made in the 1900s, embodies all the refinement of Belle Époque decorative art. Its precious wood structure, patinated by time, reveals meticulous craftsmanship where each curve, each joint testifies to demanding artistry. Its three panels are covered in a sumptuous period fabric, whose floral, scroll, and leaf motifs create a veritable textile lacework. The delicately woven patterns evoke the elegance of early 20th-century bourgeois interiors, where floral ornamentation and sinuous lines dominated the prevailing taste. Both a functional object and a decorative piece, this screen is distinguished by its timeless charm. It tells a story, that of an art of living where aesthetics and utility blended naturally, and where each element of the furniture contributed to
