This magnificent bronze sculpture, cast in the first half of the 20th century, represents a masterful reinterpretation of Edgar Degas' iconic masterpiece, "Little Dancer of Fourteen Years". The work brilliantly captures a fleeting moment of rest during an intense ballet rehearsal. A complex two-tone patina lends the sculpture a particular aesthetic elegance: the deep dark-brown hue of the figure itself contrasts strikingly with the rich green patina on the ballerina's tutu. The textured, deliberately sketch-like surface of the metal masterfully imitates Degas' extraordinary modelling style, catching the slightest play of light and shadow.
