19th-Century Antique Bronze - Ondine by Mathurin Moreau (1822-1912), France Ondine, also known as Dragonfly, is a period bronze sculpture by Mathurin Moreau, dating from around the mid-19th century. It depicts a young woman--Ondine, the water goddess. Seated on a rock surrounded by reeds, with a jug at her feet pouring an eternal stream of water, the nymph gazes downward, her head gently tilted, lost in thought. Her posture is graceful. She is nude beneath a light veil draped over her small decorative wings, and a soft smile graces her serene face, framed by elegantly styled curly hair. This refined bronze bears the signature of the artist, "Mathurin Moreau," and rests on a detachable gilt metal base. It features both gold and medal patinas. With its delicate artistry, this
