Its rectangular top, edged with an inverted quarter-round molding, rests on four turned legs connected by an H-shaped stretcher, lending it both stability and elegance. The solid oak, with its warm patina, reveals a harmonious grain and a beautiful depth of tone. The table features a discreet and functional central drawer in the apron, adorned with its original knob. Its balanced proportions make it an easy piece to incorporate into any space, whether as a small writing desk, a side table, or a refined console table.
