Corbier's delicate touch reveals a keen sense of observation and a particular sensitivity to rural scenes. Each element contributes to the tranquil poetry that emanates from the composition. Gaston Corbier (1869-1945) was a French painter from Saintes, in the Charente-Maritime region. Deeply attached to his homeland, he specialized in Charente landscapes, seascapes, and rural scenes, which he depicted with a delicate touch and a harmonious palette. Influenced by the plein air tradition and the legacy of the Port Berteau Group, he developed a sensitive style, attentive to soft light and natural atmospheres. Active until the 1930s, he left behind a coherent and sought-after body of work, regularly featured on the art market.*****Period: Early 20th century. Very good condition.
