A sumptuous cushion crafted from a remarkable antique 19th-century brocaded silk fabric, in deep, luminous shades of vibrant fuchsia. The richly ornamental design is arranged around an elegant, symmetrical central medallion, evoking a stylized vegetal motif with almost architectural lines. It is delicately surrounded by a profusion of foliage and flowers in soft shades of green, powder pink, and ivory. On either side, generous cornucopias overflow with a refined fruit motif: bunches of grapes with bluish accents, pears in subtle tones, and finely drawn leaves. At the bottom, large, open flowers with fringed petals balance the composition, bringing movement and elegance to the whole. The fineness of the weave and the slight relief of the brocade delicately capture the light, revealing the full richness of the

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design and the quality of this antique fabric. The cushion is lined with a soft, luminous silk and closes with a discreet zipper.
