Description

This English revolving bookcase in solid mahogany is a refined piece, combining decorative elegance and ingenuity. It rests on a rotating base that allows easy access to the books displayed on each side, while maintaining a compact footprint. The top immediately catches the eye thanks to its light wood marquetry forming a delicate rosette, a rare detail that brings brightness and sophistication to the whole. The mahogany structure has a deep, warm patina, while the openwork uprights typical of English revolving bookcases give the piece a beautiful visual lightness. The various storage levels offer generous capacity for hardcover books, novels, paperbacks, or decorative objects. The piece is distinguished by its balanced silhouette, characteristic of the late Victorian style, which
