### Description

A rare bronze clock dating from the early 19th century, made during the Directoire period. It depicts Bacchus, an emblematic mythological figure, finely sculpted with great attention to detail. The piece is enhanced by its original gilding, still well preserved, and a beautiful green patina attesting to its authenticity and age. This clock is equipped with a screw-in wire movement, characteristic of clocks produced during this period. The dial is signed Destiny of Rouen, a renowned clockmaker, adding historical value and a further guarantee of quality to the piece. A decorative and collectible object, this clock combines neoclassical elegance, artisanal craftsmanship, and historical significance. It would be perfectly at home in a refined interior, a collection of antique clocks, or in the possession
