### Description

A pair of green glass vases with polychrome enamel decoration depicting birds perched among flowering branches, with insects and berries. The baluster shape with flared necks rests on a foot edged with a gilt band. The set reflects the Japonisme style prevalent in Europe during the second half of the 19th century, when the decorative arts widely incorporated naturalistic motifs inspired by the Far East. The treatment of the birds and flowers, and the vibrancy of the colors, are reminiscent of this decorative trend so prevalent in ornamental glassware at the time.
